Electronic Flight Logging

A Microsoft® Excel based tool for private pilots to log flying hours for both the pilot and the aircraft and cross-refer these automatically to a maintenance schedule.

Log-It is compatible with Windows® 2000/XP and Microsoft® Office 2000 and later (untested with other versions of Microsoft® Windows/Office).

Log-It will

- Maintain the chronology of flights taken and provide an extremely simple means of summarising total hours flown – overall, up to a particular point in time or over any time interval – for different pilot operating capacities and user flight categories
- Maintain hours across different aircraft, one of which is the primary aircraft for logging purposes
- For the primary aircraft, maintain a running total of aircraft and engine-hours, allowing for change of engine if needed
- For the primary aircraft, log fuel usage in an intuitive way and average fuel consumption rate across those entries where fuel usage is logged
- For the primary aircraft, schedule key maintenance items - and then provide a reminder when items are due for service (*recent Permit to Fly criteria demand that this schedule is well kept*)
- For the primary aircraft, keep a maintenance log automatically from the maintenance schedule
- Display a graph of flying hours as a total or as any user flight category
- “forecast” flying hours for upcoming weeks based on past log entries
- Prompt pilots when key renewal dates are pending
